WHEREAS, the Mackenzie Valley Highway 1 & 7 was a no hunting corridor; and

WHEREAS, the GNWT has opened the Mackenzie Valley Highway 1 & 7 to hunting in the 1990s; and

WHEREAS, DFN has seen a significant increase of non-resident hunters in the Dehcho; and

WHEREAS, there is a safety issue with so many hunters and limited enforcement; and

WHEREAS, DFN is seeing increased pressures to the wildlife population in our area as a result of Big Game Outfitting and most recently the ban on hunting Barrenland Caribou; and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVE THAT, for the safety of our residents and the preservations of our wildlife, the Dehcho First Nations request a no hunting corridor within the asserted Dehcho Territory; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the GNWT come into adherence with the standards set out across Canada.
