**WHEREAS**, the traditional fishery on Great Slave Lake is a priority for West Point First Nation;

**WHEREAS**, West Point First Nation have concerns regarding all aspects of the fishery, including environmental issues, licensing, regulations, and fish processing;

**WHEREAS**, First Nations do not have control over how the fishery is managed;

**WHEREAS**, West Point First Nation want to see the affected First Nations gain control over all aspects of the Great Slave Lake fishery, including licensing, regulations, management, and processing;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Dehcho First Nations support West Point First Nation in holding a Regional Forum for the affected First Nations of the Great Slave Lake fishery to jointly discuss these concerns;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Dehcho First Nations support West Point First Nation in seeking ways for affected First Nations to regain control over all aspects of the Great Slave Lake fishery.
