**WHEREAS**, the West Point First Nation continue to use and occupy their traditional lands to sustain their community;

**WHEREAS**, the West Point First Nation want to create economic development within their community;

**WHEREAS**, a Motion was passed at the Dene Leadership Meeting in N'Dilo, November 19-24, 2001, in support of West Point First Nation creating a Fish Processing Plant in their community;

**WHEREAS**, West Point First Nation is also interested in exploring an opportunity for a Joint Venture to open a Bottled Water Plant, as affirmed in a June 14, 2004 Band Council Resolution;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, the Dehcho First Nations reaffirm the Dene Leadership Motion and support West Point First Nation in creating economic development with a Fish Processing Plant in their community;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the Dehcho First Nations support West Point First Nation in exploring options for a Joint Venture that would create a Bottled Water Plant within the community of West Point First Nation.
