### Part 1: Establishment of Scholarship Program

The Dehcho Land Use Planning Committee is pleased to offer a \$1,000 scholarship annually to a resident of the Dehcho Region who is enrolled in a program that will further their study and experience in the field of land management.

## Part 2: Scholarship Description

1. The Leo Norwegian Memorial Scholarship is established to honour a respected Elder who believed in his people and was concerned about the land. The Leo Norwegian Memorial Scholarship provides a \$1,000 annual scholarship for a Dehcho regional resident pursuing Postsecondary education in Environment Science, Land Use Planning, Geography, Natural Resource Management or a related field.

Leo Norwegian was a respected Elder who grew up as a hunter and trapper at Rabbitskin, a traditional Dene camp on the Mackenzie River between Fort Simpson and Jean Marie River. Family, language, and the land were very important to Leo. He taught many people through his stories from his experiences.

Throughout his life, Leo was involved in organizations that focused on taking care of the land, preserving Dene language and culture, and working with youth. He helped begin the Dehcho land claims process and was witness to the signing of the Tlicho/Dehcho Boundary Agreement on October 31, 2002 in Fort Providence. He was dedicated, outspoken and influential. He was like an encyclopedia of the Dehcho and its history.
