Nahanni National Park Reserve: Come join us to talk about the future of Nah?ą Dehé

Nahanni National Park Reserve was expanded in June 2009, making it the sixth largest park in the world. Expansion means several new jobs will be open to people in the Dehcho Region. In regards to infrastructure, a park visitor centre for Fort Simpson is proposed along with an expanded office, as well as a new field office in Nahanni Butte. These exciting opportunities will be discussed at a series of upcoming community open houses.

To give direction to the management of both the original park and the expansion area a new management plan is being developed. The Nah?ą Dehé Consensus Team will be asking for input on the management plan at a series of upcoming open houses, as well as providing information about new jobs and infrastructure, and traditional subsistence use in the park. Each open house will include a presentation with a first-hand account of the summer student work experience program and training opportunities with Parks Canada.
