THEREFORE, by our inherent right to govern ourselves, the Leadership of Deh Cho First Nations affirms that it is as committed to building Deh Cho administrative capacity in the DCFN and community offices as it is to regaining self-government;

AND THEREFORE, the DCFN Leadership affirms its commitment to make decisions and provide direction affecting Deh Cho staff to support the process of administrative capacity building with respect, fairness, and consistency;

AND THEREFORE, the DCFN Leadership expresses its appreciation to the Deh Cho staff for their patience with continual changes to operations in the DCFN and community offices, and for their commitment during these transitional years.
