RE: INTERNATIONAL ACTION

Whereas there is an opportunity to file a Confidential Procedure at the UN Commission of Human Rights; and

Whereas there are a number of international laws that are being violated by Canada that lead to gross and consistent violations of the Deh Cho Peoples' rights:

1. Violation of Treaties 8 & 11

- Canada's attempts by population transfer related to industrial activity in the Deh Cho region without Deh Cho consent
- 3. Use of the doctrine of discovery to license and permit various activities related to land and resources
- 4. Canada's violation of article two of the United Nations Charter which mandates State governments to observe and respect the sovereign rights of all peoples and their territory and its' integrity
- 5. Deh Cho Peoples perceive that their rights in their territory is being consistently violated by Canada and its officials
- 6. The Deh Cho Peoples are living in a colonial situation in need of UN intervention and remedy

Therefore be it resolved that the leadership hereby direct that the action necessary to file a confidential procedure with the UN be coordinated by administration as soon as possible.
