Resolution #10-05-00 RE: Free Entry

WHEREAS, the Canada Mining Regulations purport to allow prospectors to stake claims and acquire mineral rights on First Nations land without any consultations with First Nations; and

WHEREAS, this "free entry" system has serious impacts on Deh Cho communities; and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of Canada has held that First Nations' lands cannot be impacted without first holding good faith consultations with First Nations; and

WHEREAS, the free entry system is therefore illegal; and

WHEREAS, Canada has refused to modify the free entry system in an interim measure agreement.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT,

- 1. The DCFN Grand Chief is directed to write to the Minister of Indian and Northern Affairs to inform him that the D CFN will challenge the free entry system through the courts if negotiations on the Mining Regulations are not undertaken on a priority basis;
- 2. If Canada continues to refuse to negotiate changes to the free entry system, the DCFN is directed to initiated legal action to challenge the constitutional validity of the free entry system.
