Herb Norwegian Grand Chief RE: Dehcho Process - Dehcho Declaration and Implementing Treaty and Inherent Rights

WHEREAS, the Dehcho Process is grounded in upholding and implementing the Dehcho version of Treaty 11, which is a solemn and binding agreement between Dehcho Dene and the Crown; and

WHEREAS, the Dehcho Process has, since 2001, sought to articulate and implement the spirit and Intent of Treaty through a modern agreement that affirms Dehcho jurisdiction over lands, waters, and governance, consistent with inherent rights and Dene Laws; and

WHEREAS, negotiations remain ongoing and are currently focused on advancing a non-binding Agreement-in-Principle that reflects the Dehcho vision for self-determination and stewardship of our homeland; and

WHEREAS, many Dehcho First Nations members have voiced increasing concern over the prolonged nature of these discussions and the need for renewed momentum and accountability; and

WHEREAS, previous Dehcho Assemblies have passed resolutions mandating the completion of a non-binding Agreement-in-Principle, to be brought before the Assembly for decision;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT,

- Dehcho First Nations Negotiators are mandated to uphold, protect and build upon Treaty 11 and Dehcho inherent rights in all aspects of the Dehcho Process; and
- Negotiators are directed to take all necessary steps to bring forward the strongest possible non-binding Agreements-in-Principle, as quickly as possible, that advances Dehcho jurisdiction, based on Treaty and our inherent rights; and
- Negotiators must engage fully with communities throughout the process and aim to complete this phase of negotiations as efficiently and transparently as possible; and
- Upon completion, the non-binding Agreement-in-Principle will be subject to thorough community consultations, and no final decision will be made without a vote by the Dehcho Assembly.
